MCCARTY METRO FILM PROJECT

CENERAL GUIDELINES

OVERVIEW:

Starting on Sunday June 1 at 12:01 AM Eastern Time, you will have 30 days to write, shoot, and edit a short film that meets the set guidelines laid out in "Details" below. The winners will be determined by the McCarty Metro staff.

PRIZE:

The winners will be prominently featured on McCarty Metro, and Bradric Productions website, as well as our Facebook, Twitter sites, and will be featured on an upcoming Rick's Martini Bar episode.

DETAILS:

On Sunday June 1st at 12:01AM Eastern Time, I updated the website with the 4 specific details (below in red) that MUST be part of your video. Check http://www.mccartymetro.com/filmproject.html for the most up-to-date and current information.

A LIST OF POSSIBLE GENRES:

Comedy, Romantic Comedy, Thriller/Horror, Action/Adventure, Mystery, Chick Flick, Sports, Western, or Documentary

A PHRASE THAT MUST BE USED IN YOUR VIDEO:

"Remember to have your pet spayed or neutered."

AN OBJECT THAT MUST APPEAR IN YOUR VIDEO:

A moving ball. This may be a baseball, football, etc, but it must be in motion. If you do not have access to a sports ball, any round object in motion is acceptable.

ONE OTHER REQUIREMENT:

In honor of the McCarty Metro's 50th Anniversary Celebration coming in July...

You must acknowledge the McCarty Metro 50th Anniversary in some way. This can be done verbally by one of the actors, written on a sign, a cake, etc.



ED NOTE: Your film submission must abide by all of the 4 required details listed above. (Your film must fit into ONE of our posted genres, and must include our posted phrase, and must include our posted object, and must meet the fourth requirement. We must do this to ensure that no films are written, shot, or edited before the beginning of our contest. Example: A 3 minute, 40 second "comedy" film that includes the phrase "Remember to have your pet spade or neutered." in the dialogue and includes a tossed football. and mentions that the McCarty Metro is celebrating 50 years is an acceptable submission.

HOW TO UPLOAD YOUR FINISHED VIDEO

When finished, you need to save your video on your computer.

Go to http://www.youtube.com and create a YouTube account (If you don't have one already).

Click the Upload button to upload your video. While uploading, you can provide more information. In the description of the video, please provide the names of everyone involved in your production, the production team name if you have one (ours is Bradric Productions). Title and artist for any music you use.

Once the upload is complete, YouTube will provide you with the web address that your video can be viewed from. Forward that web address to the McCarty Metro at mccartymetro@gmail.com. Besides the link, provide me with the name of the video, info of your staff, actors, etc., and production team name.
