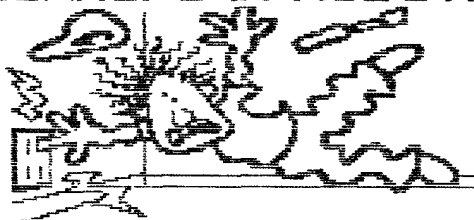
ED. WIFE NOTE- THERE BETTER BE POSTAGE ON IT IF IT GOES IN THE MAILBOX.

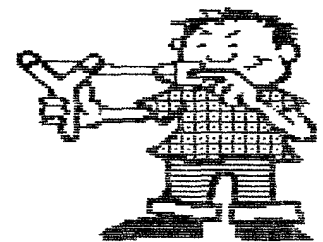
